Average publication lag time of an article was further reduced to 2-3 weeks.

Journal of Neoplasm (IPJN) is an open-access journal; double-blinded peer-review process has been followed in our journal.

In the peer-review process, the reviewer would take 7-14 days to submit their valuable comments. It would take 21-25 days to complete the whole process, articles were published from authors all around the world.

I am pleased to mention the achievement of the journal of Neoplasm during the year 2019, all issues of Volume 4 were published online well within the time and the print issues were also brought out. Journal of Neoplasm (IPJN) during this year also brought out 16th International Conference and Exhibition on Alzheimer's disease. Conference proceedings have published Online. The Impact Factor of Journal of Neoplasm (IPJN) of the year 2018 was 0.84, along with that journal is also indexed with China National Knowledge Infrastructure (CNKI), Publons, Google Scholar and Secret Search Engine Labs. Journal follows the rule of strict publication ethics. During the calendar year 2019, Journal of Neoplasm (IPJN) received a total of 25 articles, out of which 10-15 articles were rejected in the preliminary screening check due to plagiarism or being out of the formatting issue. During 2019 around 15 articles were subjected to the peer-review process and were sent for a minor revision.

During the calendar year 2019, a total of 3 Editors, 10-15 Reviewers joined the board of IPJN and contributed their invaluable services towards contribution as well as publication of articles. I take this opportunity to acknowledge the contribution of (Ken He Young) during the final editing of articles published and the support rendered by the editorial assistant, Danielle Smith in bringing out issues of IPJN in time. I would also like to express their support in bringing out yet another issue release of volume 5 in my gratitude to all the authors, reviewers, the publisher, the advisory and the editorial board of IPJN, the office bearers for IPJN and look forward to their unrelenting support to bring out the issue 2 of Journal of Neoplasm (IPJN) in scheduled time.
